Regulations

1. Due to inconvenience caused by excessive noise and other stall holders, tailboard sales and/or auctions are not permitted, unless agreed with by the committee, also the use of loudhailers is not permitted.
2. Each stall holder is to ensure his/her site is clean at the end of each day. Cardboard containers and litter are to be disposed of in the litter skips provided.
3. The sale of draw tickets or any form of lottery is prohibited.
4. Stall holders are not to put their wares around the site, i.e. balloons or trinkets
5. The sale of food, drink, ice cream, sweets etc is limited and accepted only under agreement with the organisers.
6. Money cannot be refunded if for any reason stall holders are unable to attend.
7. Owner or operator must be covered by Public Liability Insurance.
8. The committee reserves the right to close down any stall whose owner or operator infringes any of these regulations.
9. The Cornish Tractor Club reserves the right to refuse any application.
